


## Printer Setup in Mac

If you are connected to SSID "Suite 301 Tenant" please check if the printers just work without any changes needed to be made.

If you are connected to SSID "IE Partners" or if connected to "Suite 301 Tenants" and printers are not working. Please do the following

1. Top left Apple Icon please go to System Preferences and Select Printers
2. Click on Add Printer See below



See below the screen. Please use IP 10.1.10.5 for HP Officejet Pro 8620 in the address circled. Please change "Name" from IP which is prefilled to Officejet Pro 8620 or the name of the corresponding printer. I have circled the IP address next to "Name"
